



Crew Leader II (Assistant Sports Turf Manager)

The City of Elizabethtown is receiving applications for a Crew Leader II (Assistant Sports Turf Manager). This position involves supervisory and skilled work pertaining to the operation and maintenance of the Elizabethtown Sports Park athletic fields and grounds. The Crew Leader reports directly to the Turf Manager/Maintenance Superintendent and/or Park Director. Under his/her supervision, the Crew Leader directs and participates in the maintenance of athletic fields, landscaping, and related work as required. He/She typically supervises the maintenance and repair of motorized and other mechanical equipment; and may serve in the Turf Manager/Maintenance Superintendent's capacity during absences.

- Associates degree in Turf Management or related area preferred but quality of prior experience will be considered heavily if candidate has no formal education, ***strong baseball/softball experience desired.***

Elizabethtown Sports Park is a 158 acre youth sports complex currently under construction in Elizabethtown, Kentucky. The Sports Park will be owned and operated by the City of Elizabethtown and will serve as host to regional and national sporting events. The park will also serve as another community park for local events and recreational sports. The park consists of 12 ball diamonds, 10 natural turf sports fields, 2 synthetic turf sports fields, and 1 rubberized special needs field. Additionally the park has several concession/restroom buildings, a walking trail, playgrounds, and picnic areas. Operationally, the park will also feature state of the art sports lighting, irrigation control system, and a top notch maintenance facility with quality equipment. Construction is scheduled to be completed in early summer 2012 with the park opening in July 2012.
